This scholarship is for full-time students who graduated from Sargent Public School and are currently enrolled in college. Applicants must have completed one year of college and may **reapply yearly**. The scholarship is for \$ 1,000 per year, divided equally between semesters, and three (3) scholarships are to be awarded annually. The payment is made to your college at the beginning of each semester. Applicants will be notified by May 1st if awarded a scholarship.

1. **A photocopy of your college transcripts. Must have a C+ average.**
2. **A College Activity Resume for activities since your high school graduation:** honors/awards, volunteer involvement, extracurricular activities, and employment

The video should be submitted via Google Drive or YouTube. Instructions are attached, and questions should be directed to Kristin Slagle.
4. **1 Letter of Recommendation** – One (1) from a college professor or your current employer. You may also use a college volunteer activity leader. **The letter of recommendation may be sent directly, either by mail or email, but it must be signed and received by April 1.**

Tips for submitting your video essay

There are two simple options of submitting your scholarship application video essay: YouTube or Google Drive. You'll find directions for both options below!

First, please double check your video's privacy settings to ensure reviewers will be able to view it during our review process (Youtube –the video should be set to "unlisted." Google Drive – link sharing must be turned on).

[How to upload to Google Drive](#)

On iPhone and iPad

Before you start make sure that you have the Google Drive app downloaded and that you are signed in to your Google account.

1. Navigate to the Camera app on your phone and select the "**Video**" option
2. The red record button starts and ends recording your video
3. All videos are saved within your "Photos" app
4. Click on the video you wish to share and then hit the **Share Icon** to see the apps where you can share your video. Google Drive is recommended for this purpose.



Uploading to Google Drive

1. Click on the Google Drive icon
2. It will then prompt you to pick which account you want to share it to.
3. Select the folder that you wish to upload the video to. You can also create a new folder if you wish by hitting "**Select Folder**" then "**My Drive**" and tapping on the add a folder icon
4. Lastly tap "**Upload**" in the upper right corner of your screen
5. You will need to make sure on the "**Share**" option, you select anyone with a link. Share the video to **kmcslagle@gmail.com**

On Android

Before you start make sure that you have the Google Drive app downloaded and that you are signed in to your Allegheny account. If you wish to upload to YouTube directly from your smartphone make sure that you also have the YouTube Studio & YouTube apps downloaded respectively.

1. Navigate to the "Camera" app on your phone and switch to the video option
2. Press the red record button to get started
3. When you are finished press the red record button to end the video

4. All videos are saved within your phone's gallery app.



Uploading to Google Drive

1. Navigate to the video that you wish to send to Google Drive and then tap on the Share Icon
2. You will then be prompted to select a destination for your video. Scroll until you find the Google Drive icon
3. Once you select to save the video to Drive you will then be prompted on the next screen to select where in your Drive to save the video
4. You will need to make sure on the “Share” option, you select anyone with a link. Share the video to kmcslagle@gmail.com
5. For instructions on how to upload to YouTube from your desktop please follow [these instructions](#).
6. Select the folder that you wish to upload the file to. You can also create a new folder by tapping on the folder destination and then selecting the create a folder icon (shown below right)
7. Lastly tap “save” in the lower right corner of your screen

How to upload a video to YouTube using a browser

1. Sign in to a Google account.

YouTube uses Google accounts. If you don't already have a Google account, you will need to create one. You can do that [using this link](#). Navigate to YouTube.com. Make sure that you're signed in to the right Google account on YouTube. You can check this by clicking the profile icon on the top right of the YouTube website. This will show the email address that you're signed in with on YouTube.

2. Upload your video

Click the video camera icon in the upper right, and select “Upload video.” A pop-up window will open, where you can either select your video file or drag and drop it into the pop-up. Once you've selected your video file, YouTube will start the uploading process. How fast this process takes will depend on the size of the video file and the speed of your Internet connection.

3. Finish the details

You can give the video a title, and have to choose if it was created for children -either option works for this purpose. Other options can be skipped. You will need to choose the visibility setting of the video. Make sure you choose “Unlisted.” This means the video will be only viewable by people with a link to it. It will not show up in search results or be publicly viewable. This will protect your privacy and keep your video confidential.

6. You will need to make sure on the “**Share**” option, you select anyone with a link. Share the video to kmcslagle@gmail.com

How to upload a video to YouTube using a phone

1. Open the YouTube app and sign in

First, open the YouTube app. Make sure you’re logged into the right Google account if you have multiple (look in the top right corner).

2. Upload your video

Click the video camera icon next to the search icon. You’ll be taken to a screen where you have two big buttons (“record” and “go live”) as well as all your videos underneath. The YouTube app immediately picks up all the video files on your phone and neatly presents them to you. Select the video file you wish to upload.

2. Finish the details

You can give the video a title, and have to choose if it was created for children -either option works for this purpose. Other options can be skipped. You will need to choose the visibility setting of the video. Make sure you choose “Unlisted.” This means the video will be only viewable by people with a link to it. It will not show up in search results or be publicly viewable. This will protect your privacy and keep your video confidential.
